**Signing of a Memorandum of Understanding with Astroscale
to Create a Market for the Secondary Use of Satellites**

Sumitomo Mitsui Finance and Leasing Company, Limited (President: Tetsuro Imaeda; hereinafter "SMFL") and SMFL MIRAI Partners Company, Limited (President: Akira Ueda; hereinafter "SMFL MIRAI Partners"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of SMFL, have announced that they have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter "MoU") with Astroscale Japan Inc. ("ASJP") to create a secondary use market for satellites, including the development of an operating leasing business for satellites using ASJP's on-orbit services under development.

Astroscale is committed to advancing a circular economy in space through on-orbit servicing, such as debris removal, inspection of objects, satellite life extension and refueling. The company aim to move away from the conventional approach of developing disposable satellites and rockets, and instead enhance the sustainability of satellite operations by building a circular economy in space—one that enables reduction, reuse, repair, refueling, and removal.

In December 2023, the SMFL Group signed a memorandum of understanding with the Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA) to co-create a business concept for the "satellite leasing business and secondary use business," and is working to create a system to support new players entering the space industry.

Through the signing of this MoU, we will combine the strengths of the SMFL Group and ASJP to explore the possibility of developing and co-creating services that combine on-orbit services and leasing.
